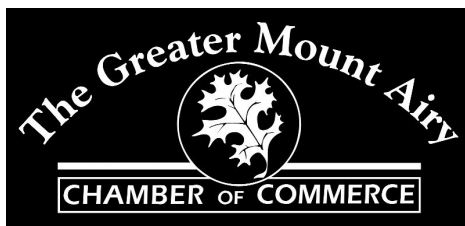
This seminar introduces breakeven analysis as a tool to assist the entrepreneur in measuring financial feasibility.
